## CONDITIONS OF FULFILMENT

### LECTURES AND PRACTICE

PREREQUISITES	Due to the faculty's regulations those students can sign up for this subject who have successfully accomplished the subject Public Design 2 and Architecture of Workplaces 1.
PRESENCE AND OTHER CONDITIONS	Attendance of lectures and consultations. Only the active practice; consultation and presentation counts for presence.

TASK AND FORM	During the practice lessons the students have to design a smaller industrial plant or commercial-service establishment of 600-700 m <sup>2</sup> due to "Design instruction and information". Students complete their task individually. During the course two common mid-term presentations/ evaluations are to be completed.
PRESENCE	Participation in 70% of the lessons is set as a condition. Only the active practice counts for presence. In case of absence from more than 30% of the total number of lessons the credits of the subject cannot be obtained. Max. 4 lessons absence is allowed.
SCHEDULE OF HANDING IN	The submission of mid-term presentations may be delayed by the maximum of 1 week, but <b>in case of a delayed submission, the value of the project is reduced by 20%!</b>
MIN. REQUIREMENT OF ACCOMPLISHMENT	Accomplishment of all mid-term hands-in with at least pass level. On time submission and accomplishment of the final project with at least pass level. By the deadline due to the timetable the final project must be handed in – irrespectively of its readiness. <b>In case of missing the final, delayed submission deadline the credits of the subject cannot be obtained!</b>
CONDITIONS OF COMPLEMENTATION	At the final evaluation of the subject the quality of the submitted final project, the results of the mid-term presentations and the quality of the students work throughout the semester will be considered. The final mark is not necessarily the average of the separate marks given during the semester.
